### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 21st day of January 1986

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 51 (9) and 60 (1) (e) of the Nurses Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

---

### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Nurses Regulations 1979, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Nurses Regulations 1979\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1986.

**2. Fees**—Regulation 25 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 5 of the Nurses Regulations 1979, Amendment No. 7) is hereby amended—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1986, increase the fees payable for annual practising certificates from \$10 to \$13, and from \$20 to \$26. The \$26 fee is for a certificate issued to any person who has not held a practising certificate in either of the 2 preceding years.
