ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 7th day of July 1969

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Niue Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Niue Reserved Enactments Order 1969.

2. Reserved enactments—The following enactments are hereby declared not to be reserved enactments for the purposes of section 38 of the Niue Act 1966, namely:

- (a) Parts XVI and XVII of the Niue Act 1966;
- (b) The Cook Islands Treasury Regulations 1959*.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is that an Ordinance of the Niue Island Assembly will not be invalid on the ground that it is repugnant to any provision of Part XVI (land development) or Part XVII (housing improvement) of the Niue Act 1966 or of the Cook Islands Treasury Regulations 1959, which are in force in Niue.
