## THE NIUE RESERVED ENACTMENTS ORDER 1970

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of August 1970

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Niue Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Niue Reserved Enactments Order 1970.

**2. Reserved enactments**—The following enactments are hereby declared not to be reserved enactments for the purposes of section 38 of the Niue Act 1966, namely:

- (a) Part XXVII and section 712 of the Niue Act 1966:
- (b) The Land and Income Tax Act 1954:
- (c) The definition of the term “church purposes” in section 2 of the Niue Amendment Act (No. 2) 1968.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

The effect of this order is that it will be competent for the Niue Island Assembly to make ordinances notwithstanding that they may be repugnant to any of the enactments referred to in Clause 2 of the order.
