PURSUANT to the Niue Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

# ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Niue Reserved Enactments Order (No. 2) 1969.

2. Reserved enactments—The following enactments are hereby declared not to be reserved enactments for the purposes of section 38 of the Niue Act 1966, namely:

- (a) Parts X to XV, Part XVIII, sections 492 to 496, section 499, Parts XXIV, XXV and XXVIII, and section 700 of the Niue Act 1966:
- (b) Part IV, section 47, and Part VII of the Niue Amendment Act (No. 2) 1968.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The effect of this order is that it will be competent for the Niue Island Assembly to make Ordinances relating to land in Niue, notwithstanding that they may be repugnant to any of the enactments referred to in clause 2 of this order.
