THE NATIONAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP REGULATIONS 1950, AMENDMENT NO. 1

Pursuant to section 12 of the Scientific and Industrial Research Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the National Research Fellowship Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the National Research Fellowship Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 9, and substituting the following regulation:—
- "9. All the sums specified in regulation 8 hereof are expressed in New Zealand currency."
- 3. The principal regulations are hereby further amended by adding the following regulations:—
- "17. At the expiry of the tenure of a fellowship awarded under these regulations or of any extension thereof, the holder, in consideration of the award of the fellowship and of the payment of moneys thereunder, shall for a period of not less than two years either reside in New Zealand or serve New Zealand interests in some sphere overseas approved by the Permanent Secretary.
- "18. For the purpose of securing fulfilment by the holder of a fellowship of the obligations imposed by regulation 17 hereof, the Minister may require the holder, as a condition of the award of the fellowship, to enter into a bond in such form and for such amount, not exceeding the total amounts payable to or on behalf of the holder under regulation 8 hereof during the term of the fellowship and any extension thereof, as the Minister thinks fit."
