**THE NATIONAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP REGULATIONS
1955, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 24th day of June 1957

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Scientific and Industrial Research Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Research Fellowship Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the National Research Fellowship Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraphs (c) and (d) of subclause (4), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(c) In the case of any fellowship awarded after the commencement of this paragraph, and of any fellowship awarded before the commencement of this paragraph if the term of the fellowship has not then expired, travelling expenses incurred (whether before or after the commencement of this paragraph) in travelling from his home to the institution where he will be undertaking his research, and in returning from that institution to his home or other place approved by the Permanent Secretary, which travelling expenses may, where the holder travels overseas to do his research, include return fares for surface travel at tourist class rates between his home country and the country in which he will be undertaking his research; and it is hereby declared that any amount paid to the holder of any such fellowship for travelling expenses before the commencement of this paragraph shall be deemed to have been paid to him on account of the amount which may be paid to him under this paragraph.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The principal regulations provided for payment of travelling expenses not in excess of £50 for travel to and from Australia and not in excess of £200 for travel to and from countries other than Australia. These regulations do not specify a maximum amount which may be allowed as travelling expenses, but provide for payment for surface travel at tourist class rates.
