**THE NATIONAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP REGULATIONS
1955, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 15th day of February
1960

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Scientific and Industrial Research Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Research Fellowship Regulations 1955, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the National Research Fellowship Regulations 1955* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definitions of the terms "University of New Zealand", "constituent college", and "Professor of the University", and substituting in their appropriate alphabetical order the following definitions:

"'Professor of the University' has the meaning assigned to that term by section 2 of the New Zealand University Amendment Act 1926:

"'University of New Zealand' means the University of New Zealand as reconstituted by section 2 of the New Zealand University Amendment Act 1957."

3. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a) of subclause (4), and substituting the following paragraph:

"(a) Either—

"(i) A refund of any fees (other than examination fees) payable to any University that is a constituent institution of the University of New Zealand or to any other institution approved by the Permanent Secretary, together with a further sum not exceeding £50 in the aggregate for the purchase of any books, apparatus, or service specially required for the purpose of carrying out his research and towards the cost of his travelling expenses while engaged thereon:

“Provided that the said sum of £50 may, in the event of the fellowship being extended, be exceeded at the discretion of the Permanent Secretary, but in no case shall payments under this proviso exceed £100; or

“(ii) A sum not exceeding £100 in the aggregate for the purchase of any books, apparatus, or service specially required for the purpose of carrying out his research and towards the cost of his travelling expenses while engaged thereon, and for any fees (other than examination fees) payable to any University that is a constituent institution of the University of New Zealand or to any other institution approved by the Permanent Secretary:

“Provided that the said sum of £100 may, in the event of the fellowship being extended, be exceeded at the discretion of the Permanent Secretary, but in no case shall the amounts payable under this subparagraph exceed £200:”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations vary the payments that may be made to the holder of a National Research Fellowship.
