**THE NURSERY REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 11th day of
March, 1942.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Nursery Registration Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Nursery Registration Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. Clause (3) of Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the words " and by the expiring certificate of registration ".

4. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting next after clause (4) thereof the following additional clause :—

"4A. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this regulation, upon the issue of a receipt for the fee payable pursuant to clause (5) of Regulation 3 hereof in respect of an application for the re-registration of a nursery, the nursery to which the application relates shall, subject to the provisions hereinafter contained, be deemed to be registered with the same certificate of registration as that with which the nursery was then last registered for a further period expiring on the 30th April in the year next following the date of the receipt for such fee, and it shall not be necessary to issue a further certificate of registration in respect of that nursery in regular form."

5. The form numbered 1 in the Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by deleting the words "together with the expiring certificate of registration (if any) ".
