ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 20th day of June 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 16 and 31 of the Plants Act 1970, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Nursery Registration Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Nursery Registration Regulations 1954* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the definition of the term “the Act”, the following definition:

“‘Disease’ includes any pest:”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Nursery Registration Regulations 1954 by confirming that notices issued by Inspectors in respect of diseases in plant nurseries also relate to pests (as defined in the Plants Act 1970) within the nursery.
