THE NURSES REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1958,
AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of July 1960

Present:
HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Nurses and Midwives Act 1945, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Nurses Registration Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Nurses Registration Regulations 1958* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Subclause (3) of regulation 32 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "shall be £1, or, where the applicant seeks to be registered by virtue of more than one qualification, £1 for the first and 10s. for every additional qualification", and substituting the words "shall be £2, or, where the applicant seeks to be registered by virtue of more than one qualification, £2 for the first and £1 for every additional qualification".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fees for registration in New Zealand of nurses who have qualified outside New Zealand.
