REGULATIONS 1950, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Scientific and Industrial Research Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Research Scholarship Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the National Research Scholarship Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 18 (as enacted by regulation 3 of the National Research Scholarship Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 1).

(2) The National Research Scholarship Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 1, are hereby amended by revoking regulation 3.

3. The principal regulations are hereby further amended by adding the following regulation :—

“ 19. For the purpose of securing fulfilment by the holder of a scholarship of the obligations imposed by regulation 18 hereof, the Minister may require the holder, as a condition of the award of the scholarship, to enter into a bond in such form and for such amount as the Minister thinks fit, not exceeding the total amounts payable to or on behalf of the holder under regulation 9 hereof during the term of the scholarship and any extension thereof.”
