**THE COPYRIGHT AMENDING REGULATIONS 1946**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 14th day of August, 1946

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 53 of the Copyright Act, 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Copyright Amending Regulations 1946.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the fourth day after the notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

2. Regulation 9 of the regulations under the Copyright Act, 1913, relating to copyright and made on the 27th day of March, 1914\* (as replaced by Regulation 3 of the Patents, Designs, and Trade-marks and Copyright (Hours of Inspection) Regulations 1936)†, is revoked, and the following substituted :—

“ 9. The office shall be open to the public for the transaction of business on every week-day, except Saturday, between the hours of 9 a.m. and noon, and 1 p.m. and 3.30 p.m., except on the following days : The days from Good Friday to Easter Tuesday, both inclusive ; the days from Christmas Eve (or, if Christmas Eve falls on a Saturday or a Sunday, from the preceding Friday) to the 3rd January, both inclusive ; and any other day observed by the Government as a public holiday.”
