A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 1 of the Age-benefits and Invalids' Benefits (Reciprocity with Australia) Act, 1943, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as follows :—

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Age-benefits and Invalids' Benefits (Reciprocity with Australia) Act Commencement Order 1943.

2. The Age-benefits and Invalids' Benefits (Reciprocity with Australia) Act, 1943, shall come into force on the first day of September, one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.
