ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 5th day of
August, 1942.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 13, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940.*

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in Regulation 3 of the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 12, no Native within the meaning of the Native Land Act, 1931†, who is a member of any armed force shall be liable as such member for service outside New Zealand unless he voluntarily elects to perform such service.
