PURSUANT to section 57 of the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Nelson Secondary Schools Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Nelson Secondary Schools Regulations 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Board of Governors of Nayland College—(1) Regulation 6 (1) (d) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word "Waimea", and substituting the word "Broadgreen".

(2) The person who, immediately before the commencement of these regulations, held office as the member of the Board of Governors of Nayland College elected under regulation 6 (1) (d) of the principal regulations shall continue to hold that office as if—
