



**THE NELSON SECONDARY SCHOOLS REGULATIONS 1976,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of April 1982

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 57 of the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Nelson Secondary Schools Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Nelson Secondary Schools Regulations 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Board of Governors of Nayland College—(1) Regulation 6 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (d) (as amended by regulation 2 of the Nelson Secondary Schools Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(d) One member elected by the members of the School Committee of Broadgreen Intermediate School.”

(2) Subclause (1) of this regulation shall not affect the tenure in office as a member of the Board of Governors of Nayland College of the person immediately before the commencement of these regulations holding such office under regulation 6 (1) (d) of the principal regulations.

(3) The Nelson Secondary Schools Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide that in future a member of the Board of Governors of Nayland College is to be elected by the members of the Broadgreen Intermediate School Committee rather than the members of that committee and the Nelson Intermediate School Committee jointly.
