ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 31st day of  
July, 1940.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER.

1. This Order may be cited as the Noxious Weeds Act Extension Order 1940.
2. This Order in Council shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.
3. The Second Schedule to the Noxious Weeds Act, 1928, is hereby extended by including therein the plant Spanish heath (*Erica lusitanica*).
4. The Noxious Weeds Act Extension Order 1939\* is revoked.
