HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Noxious Weeds Act Extension Order 1946.
2. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1946.
3. The Second Schedule to the Noxious Weeds Act, 1928 (noxious weeds when so declared by local authority), is hereby extended by including therein the plant boxthorn (*Lycium* spp.).
