Pursuant to the Noxious Weeds Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Noxious Weeds Act Extension Order 1947.
- 2. This Order shall come into force on the seventh day after notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.
- 3. The Second Schedule to the Noxious Weeds Act, 1928 (noxious weeds when so declared by local authority), is hereby extended by including therein the plants mentioned in the Schedule hereso.

SCHEDULE

Wild onion or wild garlic (Allium triquetrum).
Wild teasel (Dipsacus silvester).
Winged thistle (Cardwus tenuiflorus).
