PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, His Excellency the  
Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the  
Executive Council, hereby makes the following Order.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Noxious Weeds Act Extension Order 1952.
2. The First Schedule to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950 is hereby extended by including therein the plants mentioned in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Dewberry (*Rubus caesius*).  
Montpelier broom (*Cytisus monspessulanus*).  
Wild teasel (*Dipsacus silvester*).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.]

These regulations extend the list of plants which may be declared by a local authority to be noxious weeds.
