ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 30th day of July 1962

PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Noxious Weeds Act Extension Order 1962.

2. The First Schedule to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950 is hereby extended by inserting therein, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words "Sedge (*Carex longibrachiata* also known as *Carex longifolia*)".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.
This order adds sedge to the list of plants which may be declared by a local authority to be noxious weeds.
