ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of August 1968

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Noxious Weeds Act Extension Order 1968.

2. First Schedule extended—The First Schedule to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950 is hereby extended by inserting therein, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words “Alligator weed (*Telanthera philoxeroides*)” and the words “Wild rice (*Zizania aquatica*)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.
This order adds alligator weed and wild rice to the list of plants which may be declared by a local authority to be noxious weeds.
