Pursuant to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Noxious Weeds Act Extension Order 1972.
- 2. First Schedule extended—The First Schedule to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950 is hereby extended by inserting therein, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words "Waterfern (Salvinia, any species)."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order adds waterfern to the list of plants that may be declared to be noxious weeds by a local authority.
