PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Noxious Weeds Act Extension Order 1972.

**2. First Schedule extended**—The First Schedule to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950 is hereby extended by inserting therein, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the words “Waterfern (*Salvinia*, any species).”

This order adds waterfern to the list of plants that may be declared to be noxious weeds by a local authority.
