

1965/134**THE NEW ZEALAND ARMY (VISITING FORCES) ORDER 1965**

PURSUANT to subsection (5) of section 6 of the Visiting Forces Act 1939, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the New Zealand Army (Visiting Forces) Order 1965.

2. It is hereby declared that the military forces of Her Majesty raised in New Zealand and the military forces of Her Majesty raised in Australia are serving together wheresoever serving.

3. It is hereby declared that the military forces of Her Majesty raised in New Zealand and the military forces of Her Majesty raised in Australia when serving as part of or together with the Far East Land Forces or in Australia are acting in combination.

As witness the hand of His Excellency the Administrator of the Government this 23rd day of July 1965.
