ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 19th day of February 1968

Pursuant to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand Australia Free Trade Agreement Order 1968.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January 1968.
- 2. The Customs Tariff (as set out in the Second Schedule to the Customs Act 1966) is hereby amended by revoking the items and rates of duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items and rates of duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

The effect of the order is to reduce, as from 1 January 1968, rates of duty on certain goods from Australia.
