THE NEW ZEALAND - AUSTRALIA FREE TRADE AGREEMENT ORDER 1974

PURSUANT to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand Australia Free Trade Agreement Order 1974.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on 1 January 1974.
- 2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.
- 3. Consequential revocations—(1) The New Zealand Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 6) 1971* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 48.21.001, 48.21.009, and 84.59.129.
- (2) The New Zealand Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 2) 1973† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 73.40.498, 84.22.002, 84.22.008, 97.04.021, and 97.04.029.

- (3) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 15) 1972* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 83.05.009.
