

# THE NEW ZEALAND - AUSTRALIA FREE TRADE AGREEMENT ORDER (NO. 2) 1972

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of June 1972
Present:
His Exgellengy the Governor-General in Council
Pursuant to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement-(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 2) 1972.
(2) This order shall come into force on the lst day of July 1972.
2. Tariff amended-The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items and rates of duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.
