#### THE NEW ZEALAND - AUSTRALIA FREE TRADE AGREEMENT ORDER (NO. 2) 1973

#### DENIS BLUNDELL, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of June 1973 Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 2) 1973. (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1973.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

**3.** Consequential revocations—(1) The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 6) 1971\* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 35.03.003, 39.07.399, 76.16.099, 97.06.008, and 97.06.009.

(2) The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 7) 1971<sup>†</sup> is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 97.04.001.

(3) The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 3) 1972<sup>+</sup> is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 84.22.038, 97.04.004, 97.04.005, 97.04.006, 97.06.003, 97.06.025, and 97.06.028.

(4) The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order 1973§ is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 97.06.024.

(5) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 12)  $1972\parallel$  is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 85.23.027 and 85.23.028.

(6) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1973¶ is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 84.06.125.






