AGREEMENT ORDER (NO. 3) 1971**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of June 1971

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 3) 1971.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1971.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items and rates of duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items and rates of duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. Revocations—(1) The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 4) 1969* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 58.01.12 and 58.01.19, and Chapters 74 and 98.

(2) The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order 1970† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Chapters 21 and 68.

(3) The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 5) 1970‡ is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 85.14.19.

(4) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 19) 1970§ is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Chapter 36 and items 84.17.22, 98.10.01, and 98.10.09.

(5) The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 9) 1970|| is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 20.02.22 and 20.02.23.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order is made for the purpose of giving effect to the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement signed on 31 August 1965. The effect of the order is to reduce, from 1 July 1971, the rates of Customs duty on certain goods imported from Australia.

This order also restores the Australian rate of Customs duty on certain tinned vegetables by revoking tariff item 20.02.23.
