PURSUANT to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 4) 1972.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July 1972.
- 2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking Tariff item 44.15.011.
- 3. Consequential revocations—The New Zealand Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 3) 1972* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Tariff item 44.15.011.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
