**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 10th day of July 1972

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 4) 1972.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July 1972.

**2. Tariff amended**—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking Tariff item 44.15.011.

**3. Consequential revocations**—The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 3) 1972\* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Tariff item 44.15.011.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order revokes Tariff item 44.15.011 which was included in Order No. 3 in error. The goods concerned fall to be classified within heading No. 44.14 and are already in Schedule A to the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement.
