HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 5) 1969.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1969.
- 2. The Customs Tariff (as set out in the Second Schedule to the Customs Act 1966 and heretofore modified) is hereby amended by revoking the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.
- 3. (1) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1967* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Third Schedule as relates to headings 73.36 and 74.17.
- (2) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 6) 1967† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to Chapter 59.
- (3) The Customs Tariff Amendment Order 1969; is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 76.15.13.
