ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 9th day of October 1972

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 5) 1972.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

This order is made for the purpose of giving effect to the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement signed on 31 August 1965. The effect of the order is to accord Australian hardwood pulp the same preference in New Zealand as New Zealand softwood pulp is accorded in Australia.
