PURSUANT to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 5) 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on 1 January 1975.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. Consequential revocations—(1) The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 3) 1974* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 84.24.219 and 85.23.021.

(2) The Customs Tariff (Composite) Amendment Order 1974† is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to item 13.03.013.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order exempts from duty certain casks, barrels and the like of heading 44.22; counter type coffee making machines of heading 84.17; speech training sets of heading 85.14 and battery operated clocks of heading 91.04, when imported from Australia.

It also reduces the rates of Customs duty on various other goods which were added to Schedule A of The New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement on 1 January 1967, 1969, and 1971.

It further provides for a separate Australian rate for those goods which were "FREE" when originally added to Schedule A.
