

# THE NEW ZEALAND - AUSTRALIA FREE TRADE AGREEMENT ORDER (NO. 6) 1972

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 18th day of December 1972

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 6) 1972.
  - (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1973.
- 2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items and rates of duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items and rates of duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

This order is made for the purpose of giving effect to the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement signed on 31 August 1965. The effect of the order is to reduce rates of duty on certain goods from Australia.

The order comes into force on 1 January 1973.
