**THE NEW ZEALAND - AUSTRALIA FREE TRADE AGREEMENT
ORDER (NO. 7) 1971**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 13th day of December 1971

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and section 5 of the Customs Amendment Act 1971, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in the first-mentioned Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 7) 1971.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1972.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff is hereby amended by revoking the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items, rates of duty, and exemptions from duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order is made for the purpose of giving effect to the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement signed on 31 August 1965. The effect of the order is to reduce, from 1 January 1972, the rate of Customs duty on billiard tables and certain parts of some forage harvesters imported from Australia.
