PURSUANT to section 3 of the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Act 1965, and for the purpose of giving effect to the agreement defined in that Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand - Australia Free Trade Agreement Order (No. 9) 1970.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1971.

2. Tariff amended—The Customs Tariff (as set out in the Second Schedule to the Customs Act 1966) is hereby amended by revoking the items and rates of duty specified in the First Schedule hereto, and substituting the items and rates of duty specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

3. Revocation—The Customs Tariff Amendment Order (No. 2) 1967* is hereby amended by revoking so much of the Second Schedule as relates to items 20.02.02 to 20.02.19.

The order comes into effect on 1 January 1971.
