## THE NEW ZEALAND ARMY (VISITING FORCES) ORDER 1968

## ARTHUR PORRITT, Governor-General

Pursuant to section 6 of the Visiting Forces Act 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the New Zealand Army (Visiting Forces) Order 1968.
- 2. New Zealand and Australian military forces serving together— It is hereby declared that the military forces of Her Majesty raised in New Zealand and the military forces of Her Majesty raised in Australia are serving together wheresoever serving.
- 3. When New Zealand and Australian military forces acting in combination—It is hereby declared that the military forces of Her Majesty raised in New Zealand and the military forces of Her Majesty raised in Australia, when serving together in Australia or with the Far East Land Forces, are acting in combination.
- 4. Portion of New Zealand Army serving in South Vietnam—It is hereby further declared that the military forces of Her Majesty raised in New Zealand and the military forces of Her Majesty raised in Australia, when serving together in South Vietnam, are acting in combination, and that—
  - (a) That portion of the New Zealand Army that is for the time being serving in South Vietnam as part of the Australian Forces Vietnam (Army Component) shall be under the command of the officer for the time being in command of that combined force:
  - (b) That portion of the New Zealand Army that is for the time being serving in South Vietnam as part of 1 Australian Task Force shall be under the command of the officer for the time being holding the position as Commander of that combined force.
- 5. Revocation—The New Zealand Army (Visiting Forces) Order 1965\* is hereby revoked.
