PURSUANT to section 4 of the Time Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the New Zealand Daylight Time Order 1974.

**2. New Zealand daylight time**—It is hereby declared that New Zealand daylight time shall be observed from 2 a.m. New Zealand standard time on Sunday 3 November 1974 to 2 a.m. New Zealand standard time on Sunday 23 February 1975.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order introduces New Zealand daylight time which is to be observed from 2 a.m., New Zealand standard time, on Sunday 3 November 1974 until 2 a.m., New Zealand standard time, on Sunday 23 February 1975.
