Pursuant to section 4 of the Time Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the New Zealand Daylight Time Order 1974.
- 2. New Zealand daylight time—It is hereby declared that New Zealand daylight time shall be observed from 2 a.m. New Zealand standard time on Sunday 3 November 1974 to 2 a.m. New Zealand standard time on Sunday 23 February 1975.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order introduces New Zealand daylight time which is to be observed from 2 a.m., New Zealand standard time, on Sunday 3 November 1974 until 2 a.m., New Zealand standard time, on Sunday 23 February 1975.
