## THE NEW ZEALAND EXTRADITION ACT ORDER 1941.

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 5th day of August, 1941.

## Present:

THE KING'S MOST EXCELLENT MAJESTY IN COUNCIL.

Whereas by an Order of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria in Council dated the 13th day of May, 1875,\* it was directed that an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand, the short title whereof was the New Zealand Extradition Act, 1874, should have effect in New Zealand as if it were part of the Act of the Parliament at Westminster the short title whereof is the Extradition Act, 1870:

And whereas by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand the short title whereof is the Consolidated Statutes Enactment Act, 1908, the New Zealand Extradition Act, 1874, was repealed:

And whereas by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand the short title whereof is the Extradition Act, 1908, it was in effect declared that the provisions of the Imperial Acts the short titles whereof are the Extradition Act, 1870, and the Extradition Act, 1873, respectively should be in force and apply in New Zealand subject to the modifications and alterations thereafter in the said reciting Act mentioned:

And whereas by an Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand to be cited as the Extradition Amendment Act, 1924, it was in effect provided that the provisions of the Imperial Act the short title whereof is the Extradition Act, 1906, should be in force and apply in New Zealand subject to the modifications and alterations mentioned in the Extradition Act, 1908, and by the said reciting Act certain further amendment of the Extradition Act, 1908, was also made:

Now, therefore, His Majesty in pursuance of the Extradition Act, 1870, aforesaid and in exercise of the powers in that behalf in the said Act contained doth by this present Order, by and with the advice of His Majesty's Privy Council, direct as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the New Zealand Extradition Act Order 1941.
- 2. The Extradition Act, 1908, aforesaid and the Extradition Amendment Act, 1924, aforesaid shall have effect in New Zealand as if they were part of the Extradition Act, 1870, aforesaid.
