**THE NEW ZEALAND GEOGRAPHIC BOARD (REMUNERATION
AND TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 1950**

Present :

THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the New Zealand Geographic Board Act, 1946, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the New Zealand Geographic Board (Remuneration and Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1950.

2. The New Zealand Geographic Board (Remuneration and Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1948* are hereby revoked.

3. In these regulations, unless inconsistent with the context,—

“ Board ” means the New Zealand Geographic Board established under the New Zealand Geographic Board Act, 1946 :

“ Member ” means a member of the Board who is not an officer in the service of the Crown.

4. For every day upon which a member attends a meeting or meetings of the Board, or is engaged in transacting any business of the Board pursuant to a resolution of the Board, he shall be paid a fee of £2 12s. 6d.

5. For time spent by a member in travelling to and from any meeting of the Board, or in travelling upon any business of the Board pursuant to a resolution of the Board, he shall be paid a fee or allowance at the rate of £2 12s. 6d. per day calculated to the nearest hour :

Provided that no fee or allowance shall be paid under this regulation in respect of any part of a day (from midnight to midnight) for which a member is entitled to a fee under the last preceding regulation.

6. In addition to the fees and allowances payable under the foregoing provisions of these regulations there shall be paid to a member travelling-allowance and travelling-expenses in accordance with the following provisions of these regulations.

7. (1) The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949* shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Board and its members.

(2) The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 5 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be at the rate of £1 15s. a day :

Provided that where a member is entitled to a subsistence allowance and occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional amount of 2s. may be paid to that member.

(3) The mileage allowance referred to in Regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be calculated in accordance with the following table :—

Horse-power of Car.	Mileage Allowance.
Not exceeding 9½	5½d. a mile.
Exceeding 9½ but not exceeding 14½	6½d. a mile.
Over 14½	7d. a mile

(4) Garage expenses payable to a member pursuant to this regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night on which any such expenses are incurred.
