PURSUANT to the Plants Act 1970, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the New Zealand Grown Fruit and Vegetables Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the New Zealand Grown Fruit and Vegetables Regulations 1975* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Certification fees—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after their notification in the Gazette, increase the fees payable in respect of certification under the principal regulations.
