**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Public Revenues Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the New Zealand Government Stores Control Board Regulations 1925, Amendment No. 5.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the New Zealand Government Stores Control Board Regulations 1925\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. Paragraph (b) of Regulation 1 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) By inserting in the definition of "Supplies and Tenders Committee", after the words "Public Works", the words "State Hydro-electric".

(b) By inserting in the definition of "Purchasing Department", after the words "the Public Works Department", the words "the State Hydro-electric Department".

(c) By inserting in the definition of "District Supplies and Tenders Committees", after the words "New Zealand Railways", the words "State Hydro-electric".

4. Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:—

"(f) Stores Manager of the State Hydro-electric Department."

5. Regulation 13 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "the Public Works Department", the words "the State Hydro-electric Department".
