(MYOGA) ORDER 1992**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 27th day of July 1992

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 24 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Myoga) Order 1992.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. “Myoga” defined—In this order, “myoga” means the buds, flowers, and shoots of the plant *Zingiber mioga*.

3. Myoga declared a prescribed product—Myoga is a prescribed product.

4. Myoga to be subject to export licensing—Myoga shall be subject to export licensing in accordance with Part III of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987.

5. Product group recognised—The New Zealand Myoga Product Group Limited is the product group recognised under section 25 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987 as suitable to carry out the functions of a recognised product group in relation to myoga.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force 28 days after notification in the *Gazette*, declares myoga (the buds, flowers, and shoots of a Japanese plant of the ginger family) to be a prescribed product for the purposes of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987, provides for myoga to be subject to export licensing under that Act, and names the New Zealand Myoga Product Group Limited as the product group recognised under that Act as suitable to carry out the functions of a recognised product group in relation to myoga.
