- 1 Title**
This order is the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Nashi/Asian Pear) Amendment Order 2007.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Principal order amended

This order amends the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Nashi/Asian Pear) Order 1994.

4 New clause 5 substituted

Clause 5 is revoked and the following clause substituted:

“5 Product group recognised for nashi

The body that was known as Nashi New Zealand Incorporated immediately before the commencement of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Nashi/Asian Pear) Amendment Order 2007 is the product group recognised for nashi.”

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, amends the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Nashi/Asian Pear) Order 1994 to substitute the name of Nashi New Zealand Incorporated as the recognised product group for nashi.
