ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 62 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Fees) Regulations 1993.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Fee for application for export licence**—Every application for an export licence shall be accompanied by such fee, not exceeding \$2,250 (inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985), as the Authority thinks fit.

**3. Consequential revocation**—The Horticultural Prescribed Products (Export Licence Fee) Regulations 1987\* are hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after notification in the *Gazette*, provide for the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority to fix, up to a maximum of \$2,250, the amount of the fee payable when an application for an export licence is lodged. At present, the fee is \$450.
