#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 62 of the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## **REGULATIONS**

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority (Fees) Regulations 1993.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Fee for application for export licence—Every application for an export licence shall be accompanied by such fee, not exceeding \$2,250 (inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985), as the Authority thinks fit.
- **3. Consequential revocation**—The Horticultural Prescribed Products (Export Licence Fee) Regulations 1987\* are hereby consequentially revoked.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after notification in the *Gazette*, provide for the New Zealand Horticulture Export Authority to fix, up to a maximum of \$2,250, the amount of the fee payable when an application for an export licence is lodged. At present, the fee is \$450.
