

THE NIUE (NEW ZEALAND LAWS) REGULATIONS 1972

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Niue Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Niue (New Zealand Laws) Regulations 1972.
- 2. Oil in Navigable Waters Act in force in Niue—(1) The Oil in Navigable Waters Act 1965 shall be in force in Niue.
- (2) In the application of that Act to Niue, the term "New Zealand" as used in that Act shall both in New Zealand and in Niue be read as including Niue.
- 3. Section 5 of Western Samoa Act in force in Niue—Section 5 of the Western Samoa Act 1961 shall be in force in Niue as if the reference in that section to New Zealand were a reference to Niue.
